

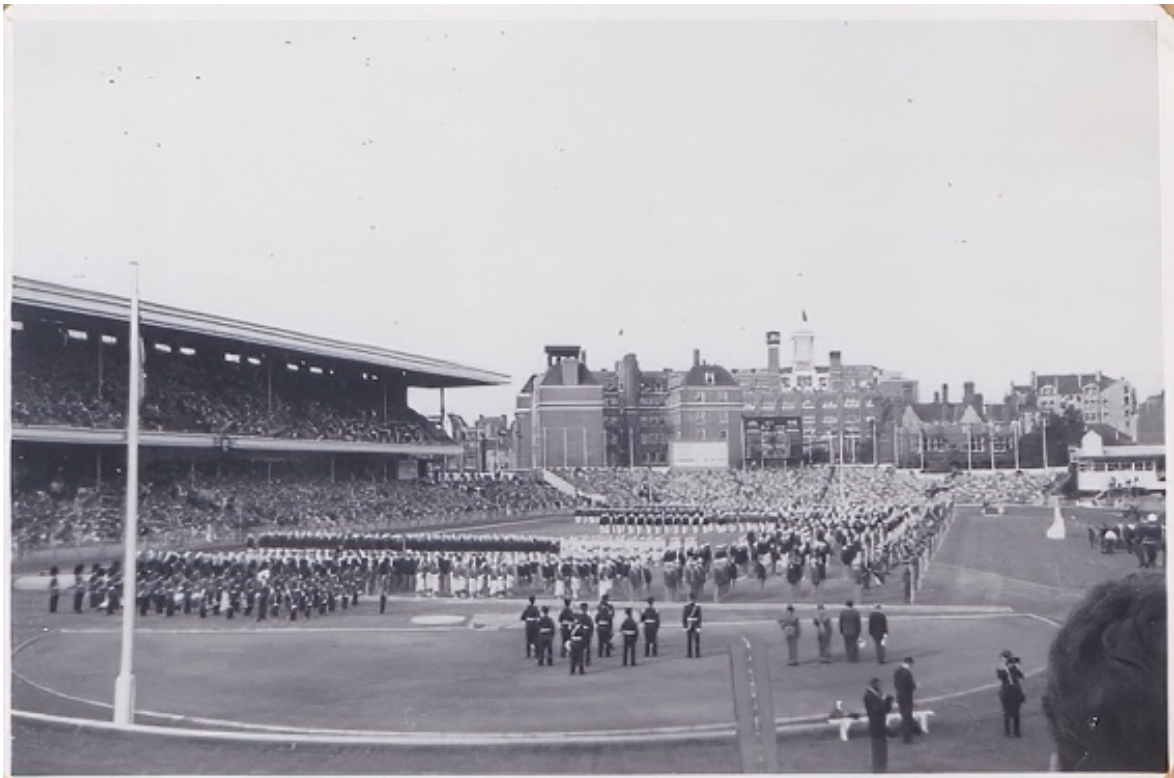
The 1958 British Empire and Commonwealth Games in Cardiff
