A BRAND NEW PROVERB

When I wrote 'Trinity Memories' I thought my folder of Trinity bits and bobs contained all that I had. Not so. Hence this brand new proverb:

A man with a cellar never throws anything away

A trawl through the underground rooms of my 100-year-old house revealed enough material for Part 2.

From the responses that I had to Part 1, the lists of names in the 'Three One-Act Plays' were of particular interest, so in Part 2 I have included the whole of the Prizegiving booklet for 1959-60 and the programmes for Sports Days in 1956 and 1960. Thirty pages of pupils names.



TRINITY GRAMMAR SCHOOL WAS IN MIDDLESEX



Until 1965, when Greater London was formed, Wood Green was part of Middlesex. The school's emblem, three seaxes (Saxon swords) topped with a Saxon crown, was the coat of arms of Middlesex (the land of the Middle Saxons) and used on everything from blazer badges to schoolbooks.

Being in Middlesex meant that the catchment area included several districts that were in the North Middlesex area – Edmonton, Enfield, Hornsey, Potters Bar, Southgate and Tottenham. These areas had their own grammar schools but for various reasons some Trinity pupils made quite long journeys each day – from Potters Bar and Enfield Lock, for example.

OTHER SCHOOLS

When it came to sports, what schools did we compete against? For athletics it was just five grammars: Glendale (also in Wood Green), Minchenden (in Southgate), Southgate County, Tollington (Hornsey) and Woodhouse (Finchley). The venue was Broomfield Park.

For football, hockey and netball, the net was cast much wider. In addition to the five above, there were also Edmonton County, Enfield Grammar, Enfield Tech, Finchley County, Hendon County, Hornsey High, Latymer (in Edmonton), Manor House, Mount Grace (Potters Bar), Orange Hill (Mill Hill), St Michaels (Enfield), Stationers (Hornsey), Tottenham County and Tottenham High.

TEACHERS

In Part 1 I mentioned that the teacher in my first year was Mrs J. Naish. From the new cellar hoard, I discover that I was in Form 1B and in the next year I was in 2B, again with Mrs Naish. In the third year I'd moved up to 3A with Mrs K.J. Shelley and Mr G.R. Morris, then 4A with Dr J. M. Campbell and 5A with Dr Mirthalinghan. I won't bore you with endless quotes from my school reports but Mrs Naish's comment in April 1957 was "Shows interest at times!"

If you are anxious to identify other teachers that taught at Trinity at that time, the 1960 Sports Day programme (shown later in Part 2) lists all the teachers who officiated.

HISTORY IN THE 5th YEAR

From what I hear, history students these days tend to do the Tudors and World War 2. Not so for class 5A in 1959/60. We stayed firmly in the 19th Century for our O Levels.

"How do you account for the failure of the German, Austrian and Hungarian revolutions in 1848?"

"Why did the Crimean War break out in 1854?"

"What were the Imperial Policies of Disraeli's Ministry 1874 – 80"

The pages of the book in which we wrote our answers measured 8 inches by six-and-a-half inches, a traditional British paper size called 'Kings'.

'FUN WITH MATHEMATICS'

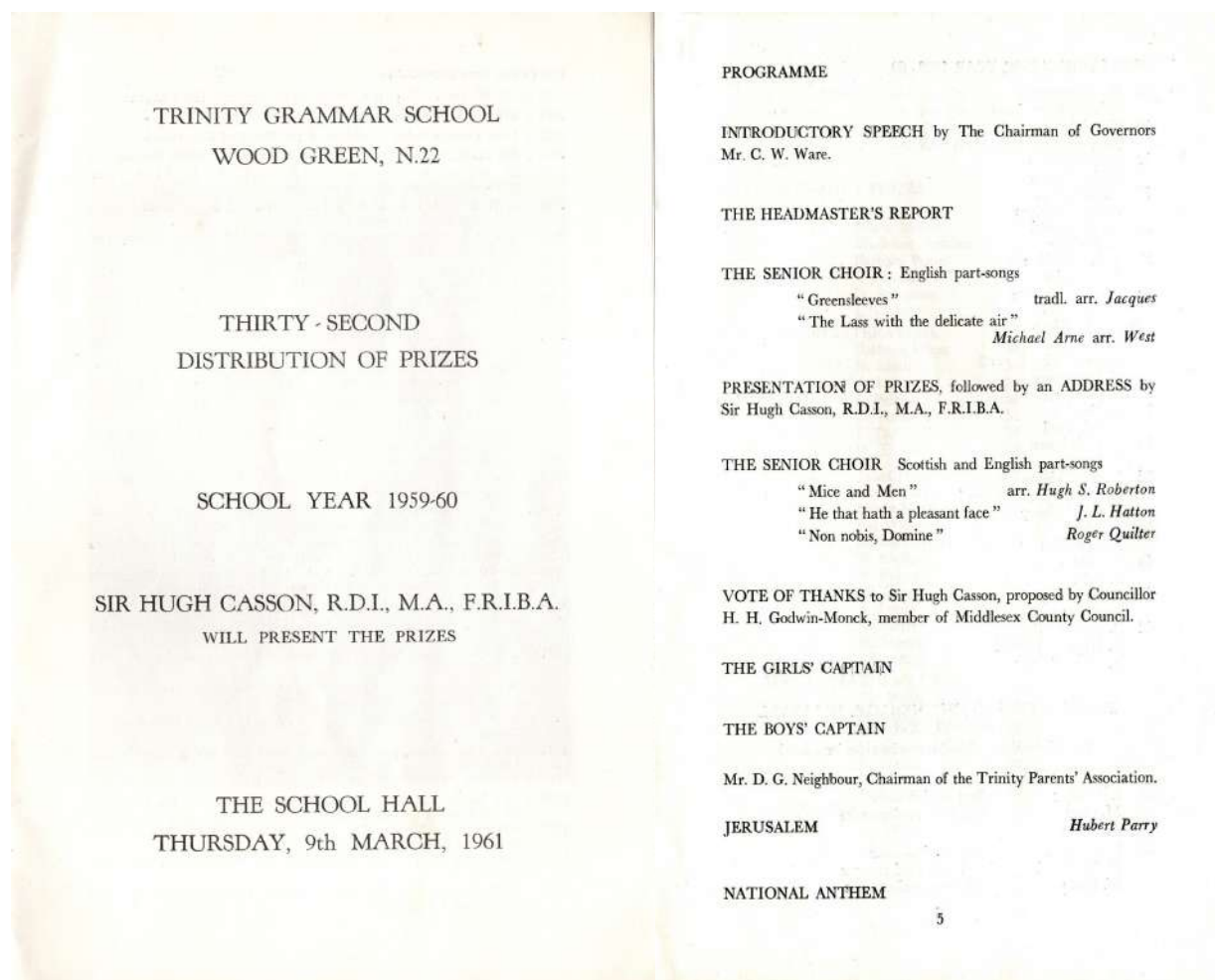
